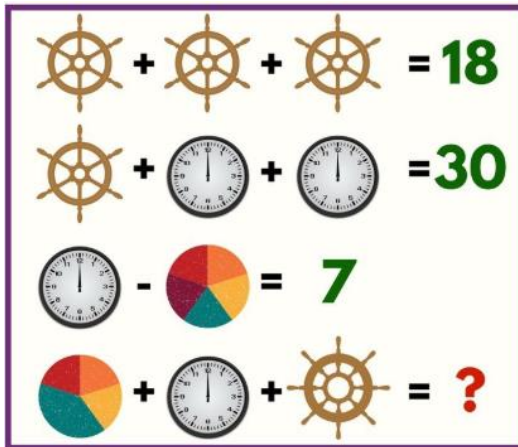
Remember – don't be sat in front of the computer or be hunched over your work for too long. Every so often (30-45 minutes) get up stretch and move around.

Using this and the dictionary link below if needed, can you define the following types of triangle and draw an accurate and annotated example.

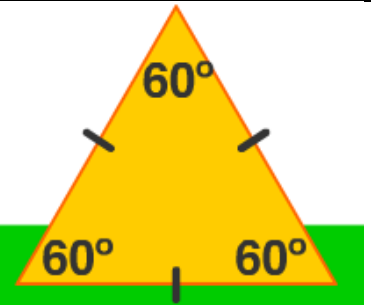
- isosceles
