Year 3 & 4 - 'Once Upon a Musical'

This year, Years 3 and 4 are performing 'Once Upon a Musical'. This new fairytale musical, an original story from Emily Martin, weaves three beloved fairy tales together to tell an innovative story of good (eventually) triumphing over evil.

The performance dates are the afternoon of Monday 23rd March at 1.30pm, the evening of Monday 23rd March at 5.30pm, and the evening of Tuesday 24th March at 5.30pm.

We are using an online form for you to book your tickets. Please ensure that you complete the form by **9am on Monday 16th March** to allow the office time to allocate all the tickets accordingly.

There is no charge for tickets to the performances, and you can apply for two tickets (total) in the first instance (e.g. one each for two performances, or two for a single performance). Should extra tickets become available after the initial allocations, we will let parents know and these will be made available on a first come first served basis with a maximum of two extra tickets per family.

We will not be issuing paper tickets this year, you will be informed of your ticket allocation via a ticket slip sent home with your child and your name will be added to the list which will be held on the door. You do not need to bring the slip with you on the day.

Please note that **no** children of primary school age or younger (including babies) will be admitted to the evening performances. If any child is brought to the evening performances, they will not be admitted.

The evening performances will begin at 5.30pm, so the children will need to be in their classroom by 5:00pm. **Children must be taken to and collected from their classroom. Children cannot walk home alone.** Collection time from the classroom will be 6:30pm. Please use the entrance gate by the main school office to drop off and collect your child, to and from their classroom. If there are any issues with attendance, please inform your class teacher as soon as possible. It is crucial that we know well in advance if your child cannot attend either of the evening performances, although we strongly request that this does not happen, unless there are exceptional circumstances. All children have their part to play, whether it's on stage, in the singing and/or dancing.

Please ensure that if your Year 4 child has lines to learn, they are practising them regularly.
