Dear Parents & Carers

Year 3 Trip to The Tower of London – Friday 20th March 2026

As part of our learning next term on 'The Tudors', we are planning to take all Year 3 children to The Tower of London. The children will attend a workshop called 'The Wives of Henry VIII' where they will learn about the real women behind the infamous 'divorced, beheaded...' rhyme and have a better understanding of the importance of the role of court in Tudor times.

The total cost of the trip is £14.00 per child. If your child is entitled to pupil premium funding, the cost is reduced to £7.00. This is a voluntary contribution; however, if we do not get enough money to pay for the trip then we will have to cancel it. Please make your payment via the Arbor App or Parent Portal.

We will be travelling to London by train and children should arrive promptly for registration at the usual time. The train from St Neots station will arrive at London Bridge station where we will take a 15-minute walk across Tower Bridge to the Tower of London. We plan on returning to school at approximately 5.30pm. This time will be confirmed nearer the time.

Your child will need the following:

- A packed lunch in a named bag. Please ensure that all items are disposable (and no fizzy drinks, yoghurts or chocolate please).
- Small rucksack/bag
- A named water bottle
- Children must wear school uniform.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather conditions on the day e.g. a jumper if cold and windy, a sun hat if it is sunny.
