## **Young Voices Choir Trip to the O2 for Year 6 - Thursday 22nd January 2026**

Young Voices is fast approaching, and we are all getting extremely excited. The children have been working very hard to learn their songs, and we are looking forward to a fantastic day and evening.

Children should come to school as normal on Thursday 22nd January, wearing full school uniform. If your child has ordered a Young Voices t-shirt, this will be given to them before departure. If your child has not ordered a t-shirt, please ensure they bring a plain white t-shirt to wear for the performance. A clean white P.E. t-shirt is perfectly suitable.

Coaches will depart school at approximately 9.15am. Upon arrival at the O2, the children will spend the day rehearsing with other schools before performing in the evening. The coach is scheduled to leave the O2 at 9.30pm, with an expected return time of approximately 11.30pm. Collection will be from **Station Square, Loves Farm.**

If there are any significant changes to these timings, parents will be updated via Class Dojo. If you are not yet signed up to Class Dojo, please do so and speak to your child's class teacher if you require any assistance.

Please ensure that you provide an emergency contact number on the slip below. This number must be available throughout the day and evening and will be used in the event of an emergency. Please also confirm the name of the adult collecting your child. For safeguarding reasons, children will not be permitted to walk home unaccompanied.

Parents who have purchased tickets to watch the performance will need to make their own travel arrangements to and from the O2 Arena. It will not be possible to collect children directly from the venue. Tickets are digital this year and will be emailed to parents who have ordered them by another school within the Trust, Winhills Primary Academy. For parents attending the event, please see the important information attached.

Children will need to bring:

- A warm coat
- Plenty of water (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles)
- Two good-sized packed lunches (one for lunch and one for dinner)

All items must be carried in one backpack-style bag, which can be easily carried and stored under a seat.

If your child is entitled to free school meals, we can provide you with **one** packed lunch (wrap, fruit and a cake/biscuit) for the trip. Please let the office know by **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> January**.

Children must **not** bring mobile phones, cameras, money, or other valuables.

If your child requires medication during the visit (for example, travel sickness medication), please contact the school office to complete the necessary consent forms. We are unable to administer medication without written permission. The medication must be in the original packaging, stating the dose to be given and frequency.

Due to the late return, children attending the concert are not required to be in school until 10.00am on Friday 23rd January. For safeguarding purposes, please complete the slip below to inform us if your child will arrive at 10.00am or the usual time of 8.45am.

If your child requires a school meal on Friday 23rd January, we will need to know this in advance. Please add your child's meal choice to the slip below. If we do not hear from you, we will assume that your child will be bringing a packed lunch on Friday.

The slip below must be returned to the class teacher or School office by **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> January 2026**.

## CONCERT TIMES

Venue doors open at **5.30pm**. Concerts starts **7pm** and finishes **8.45pm**. Arrive in good time for increased security (please see \*Bag Policy info).

## TICKETS ON ENTRY

To avoid delays at the doors, all tickets are now available exclusively through the AXS app. **Please ensure your mobile tickets are ready to be displayed on your phone screen upon arrival**, and make sure your phone is charged to avoid any issues at the door.

## MERCHANDISE

## Collecting your child from school:

**We HIGHLY RECOMMEND you meet your child back at their school, this is the safest option and will avoid a long wait at the end of the concert.**

## Collecting your child from the arena:

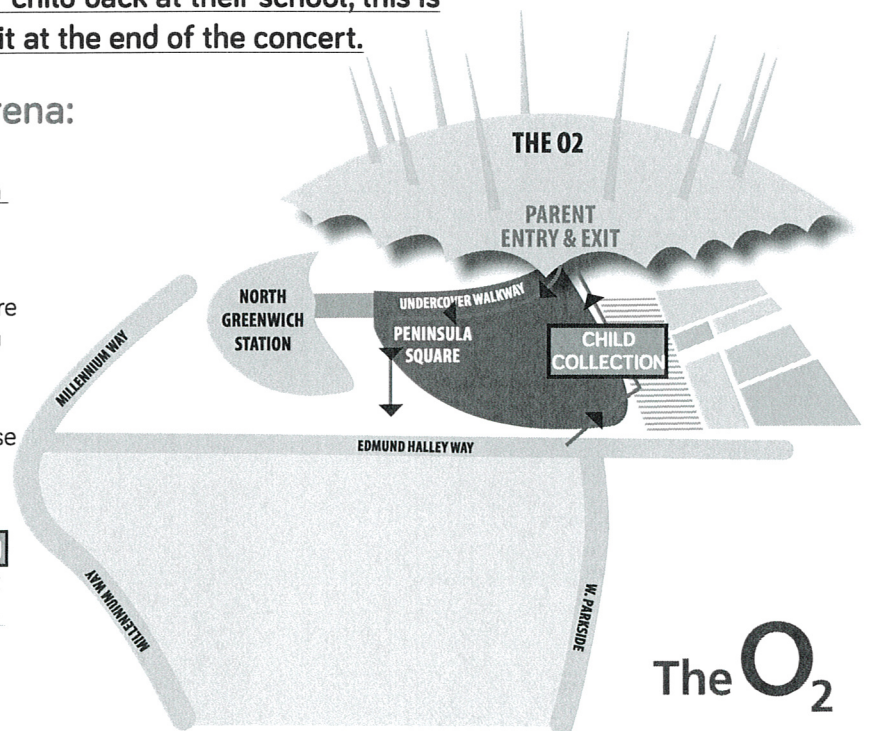
If you are collecting your child from the arena after the concert has finished you must have permission of the teacher in charge.

Parents are asked to leave via the main entrance to the building. The concourse areas must be clear before any choir is dismissed so please leave as soon as you can.

Please follow parent entry and exit routes  marked on the map to avoid delays as we will prioritise school groups at the crossing point.

- Pre-arrange with your teacher your designated child collection point within the **CHILD COLLECTION** on Peninsula Square, near the new Design District as shown on the map opposite or [click here to see the Google Map](#).

Security and marshals will be waiting to assist you. Please follow their instructions.
