Dear Parents and Carers,

After School Clubs – Spring Term 2026

Please find attached a list of the after-school clubs running this term. Not every club is open to all year groups, but there is plenty of choice. Please keep this information safe for future reference; the attached schedule shows any dates when individual clubs will not be running. As before, our after-school clubs are open to pupils in Years 1–6 in the Autumn and Spring Terms, with Reception children joining in the Summer Term. The schedule indicates which clubs are available to each year group.

How to Apply for a Club

Once again, we will be using an online form for you to apply for a place at an after school club. Please complete the form using the link or QR code below:

A separate form must be completed for each child. You will only be able to select two choices per child. If further spaces become available, we will let you know.

The form will close on **Wednesday 14th January at 5.00pm**. Any late requests must be emailed to the school office and will be processed only after all online requests have been allocated.

Please only choose clubs available for your child's year group. Your application will be acknowledged, but this does not guarantee a place. Club allocations will be visible in your child's calendar within Arbor before clubs begin. Please contact the school office if you need help accessing Arbor.

Please only request clubs your child intends to attend every week. We appreciate that the odd session may be missed due to an appointment, but in general if your child has been allocated a place at a club they should attend consistently.

Costs and Payments

The cost of the club is covered by your child's annual contribution. This contribution **must be paid before requesting any clubs**. Unfortunately, your child will not be allocated a club unless the annual contribution has been paid. **If you are paying termly for your annual contribution, you must have paid for both the Autumn and Spring Terms before a club can be assigned for this term.**

The annual contribution is £21 or £7 per term. If your child is entitled to pupil premium funding the cost of the annual contribution is reduced to £10.50 or £3.50 per term.

If you have already paid the annual contribution for the whole school year, there will be no further charge for any after school clubs for the rest of this school year.

Invitation-Only Clubs

There are several invitation only clubs this term. Both Year 5 and Year 6 **Reading Gladiators** and Year 5 and Year 6 **Maths Clubs** will run by invitation only and will start from w/c 12th January. **Homework Club** is invitation-only and will begin on Thursday 15th January. **Cooking Club** is also an invitation only club and this will start on Tuesday 20th January. If your child has a place in these clubs, you will receive a separate email or letter informing you of this. These clubs cannot be selected unless your child has received an individual invitation.

Club Timings

All non-invitation clubs will begin the week commencing w/c **19th January**.

- **Homework Club** and **Football Club (with JS Sports)** run for **one hour**, finishing at **4:15pm**.
- All other clubs run for **45 minutes**, finishing at **4:00pm**.

The final day for all clubs (including Homework Club) will be **Thursday 19th March 2026**.

Collection and After-Club Arrangements

Please indicate on the online form how your child will be leaving their club (walking home, collection by a parent, or going to Magpies). If your child will be going to **Magpies** after their club, please email magpies@roundhouse.cambs.sch.uk once you know a space has been allocated.

If you wish to cancel your child's Magpies place, you must email them with one month's notice. A future space cannot be guaranteed.

Allocations and Waiting Lists

We will do our best to ensure every child can attend at least one club. Additional choices will only be allocated if spaces remain. If your child is not allocated a place on their first choice club, they will automatically be added to the waiting list, and you will be contacted if a place becomes available.

If your child begins a club but later decides they no longer wish to continue, please inform the school office promptly so the place can be offered to a child on the waiting list.

We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring the smooth running of our after school programme. It would be very helpful if you could ensure your application is submitted before the deadline and your annual contribution is paid.
