



Christmas Events at The Round House

We have been planning Christmas activities for the children to take part in and enjoy during their time at school before the Christmas holidays.



The **Christmas Post Boxes** will be in school from Monday 1st December, one in each Key Stage. Please ensure that your child writes the full name of the child (if they know it) and the child's class clearly on each envelope so that every item of Christmas post is delivered to the correct child.

The school will be decorated by the staff after school on Friday 28th November ready for the festivities to begin. On Monday 1st December we will be having a special assembly where the children will "wish" the Christmas lights on. We are also hoping that each child will make a **Christmas decoration** at home to place on the Christmas tree in school. This can be very simple – made from card, paper and one or two glitzy bits. Please make sure decorations can be hung on the tree and are not too big! There will be a prize for the most attractive tree decoration in each year and a prize for the overall winner. Please send all decorations to school by the morning of Monday 1st December, so that they can be placed on the tree. Please ensure that the decoration has your child's full name and class on it, and then it can be returned home to decorate your Christmas tree this year.

The PTA are arranging a **Christmas Fair** after school on Tuesday 2nd December. Please see the parent mail regarding donations and posters around the school for more information. We look forward to seeing you there.

Pre-School will be learning some **Christmas songs** and plan to collate mini performances for you to view on Tapestry over Christmas. This will be so all children can participate within the sessions. We will be recording videos the week beginning 8th December. The pre-school children are welcome to wear Christmas clothes all week.

Children in Reception and Year 1 and 2 will be having a **Christmas Party** on Friday 19th December. We are asking for a voluntary donation of 50p per child which we will use to purchase food which can be enjoyed by all. Please give this directly to your child's class teacher.

Reward Day is on Thursday 18th December. Year 4/5/6 will be walking to Church on the morning on Friday 19th December for our annual carol service. Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof coat and suitable shoes for the walk with them that day.



Christmas Lunch – Wednesday 17th December 2025

We will once again be offering a Christmas lunch to all the children (except for Pre-school) on Wednesday 17th December 2025. Please be aware that there will not be an option for an alternative school meal. Please complete the on-line form by **10am on Friday 28th November** even if your child is entitled to free school meals or always has a school meal. This will enable the kitchen to order appropriately. **No orders can be placed for Christmas lunch after this time.** The menu options are:

Roast Turkey and Pigs in Blanket with stuffing, roasties, yorkshire pudding, seasonal vegetables and gravy (dairy free & gluten free available).

Vegetable Wellington and Quorn Sausage with stuffing, roasties, yorkshire pudding, seasonal vegetables and gravy (dairy free & egg free available)

There is a choice of a chocolate rice krispie cake (dairy free) or a mince pie crumble bar (dairy free & gluten free) for pudding.

We will contact parents of children who have an 'allergy aware plan' to discuss the options.
