Dear Parents & Carers

As your child has moved into Key Stage 2, we want to update you about how home reading works.

At The Round House, we want to ensure that children foster a love of reading, whilst also developing the crucial skills required to access the world around them in a positive and engaging way.

AR reading – in which children read a book at an appropriate level for themselves, before taking a short quiz to gauge their understanding – will take place in school. Children will carry out their 10 minutes of reading a day in their classrooms, as opposed to completing this at home. This time is hugely important in helping children to develop in their reading – if this time is done in school, we know that every child is achieving this goal as a minimum. This also means that physical reading diaries are no longer be sent home in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6.

As AR reading will have been completed at school, children are free to read at home whatever interests and engages them most, at whatever level they choose: this could be a magazine, a cookbook, an encyclopaedia, or even their AR book. There will be no requirement on time or frequency as we want children to read for pleasure, engaging with literature as they wish. Reading with your child is still such an important activity and a pivotal way of promoting reading; we know that this is something parents will still want to do, and we whole-heartedly promote this. A digital reading record - called Track My Read - will be used, with this extra reading being celebrated at school with a range of rewards. Please see the attached document on how to use this.

At the heart of everything, we want children to leave The Round House as able and avid readers - we believe that these changes will help everyone to move a step closer to achieving this.
