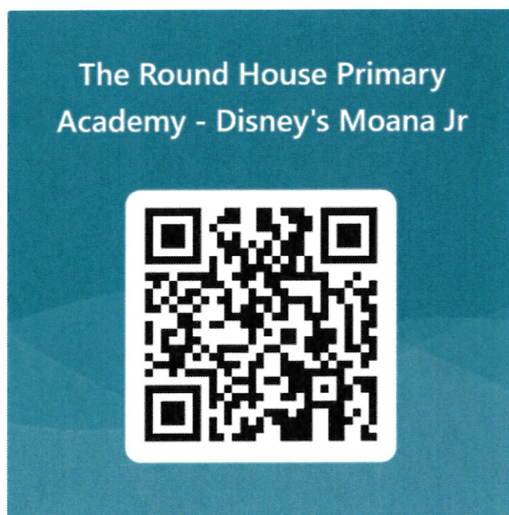
Year 5 & 6 Production of 'Disney's Moana Jr.'

Please be aware that only 2 tickets should be requested in the first instance, but you can indicate on the form that you would like to be added to a reserve list for additional tickets for the performances. The link will only be live **until Thursday 26th June 10.00am**. You **must** submit your form by this date. Any late requests will need to be emailed to the school office, and will not be processed until all online requests have been allocated. Your application will be acknowledged, but this does not guarantee your ticket allocation. Paper ticket slips will be sent home nearer to the performance date.

Please note that **no** children of primary school age or younger (including babies) will be admitted to the evening performances. If any child is brought to the evening performances they will not be admitted.

The evening performances will begin at 5:30pm, so the children will need to be in their classroom at 5:00pm. **Children must be taken to and collected from their classroom. Children cannot walk home alone.** Collection time from the classroom will be 6:30pm. Please use the entrance gate by the main school office to drop off and collect your child, to and from their classroom. If there are any issues with attendance, please inform your class teacher as soon as possible. It is crucial that we know well in advance if your child cannot attend either of the evening performances, although we strongly request that this does not happen, unless there are exceptional circumstances. All children have their part to play, whether it's on stage, in the singing and/or dancing.

Please ensure that if your Year 6 child has lines to learn, they are practising them regularly.
