Year 3 & 4 'Shakespeare Rocks'

This year, Years 3 and 4 are performing 'Shakespeare Rocks', a play based around Shakespearian times when women were not allowed to perform on stage.

The performance dates are for the afternoon of Monday 31st March at 2pm, Monday 31st March in the evening at 5.30pm, and the evening of Tuesday 1st April at 5.30pm.

We are using an online form for you to book your tickets. Please ensure that you complete the form by **10am on Friday 21st March** to allow the office time to allocate all of the tickets accordingly.

There is no charge for tickets to the performances, and you can apply for two tickets (total) in the first instance (e.g. one for each performance, or two for a single performance). You can also indicate if you would like extra tickets, if available. Please note that we cannot guarantee that we can allocate extra tickets.

We will not be issuing paper tickets this year, you will be informed of your ticket allocation via a ticket slip sent home with your child and your name will be added to the list which will be held on the door.

Please note that **no** children of primary school age or younger (including babies) will be admitted to the evening performances. If any child is brought to the evening performances they will not be admitted.

The evening performances will begin at 5.30pm, so the children will need to be in their classroom at 5:00pm. **Children must be taken to and collected from their classroom. Children cannot walk home alone.** Collection time from the classroom will be 6:30pm. Please use the entrance gate by the main school office to drop off and collect your child, to and from their classroom. If there are any issues with attendance, please inform your class teacher as soon as possible. It is crucial that we know well in advance if your child cannot attend either of the evening performances, although we strongly request that this does not happen, unless there are exceptional circumstances. All children have their part to play, whether it's on stage, in the singing and/or dancing.

Please ensure that if your Year 4 child has lines to learn, they are practising them regularly.
