Dear Parents & Carers

Young Voices Choir Trip to the O2 for Year 6 – Thursday 23rd January 2025

Young Voices is fast approaching and we are all getting extremely excited and the children are working hard at learning their songs.

Children will come to school as normal (in full school uniform) on Thursday 23rd January and, if they ordered one, will be given their Young Voices t-shirt before departure. If your child hasn't ordered a Young Voices t-shirt, they will need to bring a plain white t-shirt to wear for the performance please. A clean white P.E. t-shirt will be fine.

Coaches will depart at approximately 9.15am and once at the O2 the children will spend the day rehearsing with all the other schools and will then perform in the evening. The coach is scheduled to depart the O2 at 9.30pm and return to school at approximately 11.30pm. If there are drastic changes to these timings we will update you via Class Dojo. If you have not signed up for Class Dojo, please do so and speak to your child's class teacher if you experience any difficulty in doing this. Please ensure that an emergency contact number, that will be available all day and all evening, is provided on the slip below as this number will be used in the event of an emergency. Please also confirm on the slip the name of the adult who will be collecting your child. Please note that children will not be allowed to walk home without an adult. **Just a reminder that parents who have bought tickets to watch the performance will need to make their own way to and from the arena.** It will not be possible to collect your child directly from the O2 Arena. The tickets are digital this year and will be emailed to parents who have ordered them by another school in the Trust, Middlefield Primary Academy. For those parents attending the event, please see the important information attached.

Children will need to bring a warm coat, lots of water (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles) and **TWO** good sized packed lunches as it is a very long day (one for lunch and one for dinner). These must be carried in one backpack type bag which can be easily carried and stored under a seat.

Children **must not** bring mobile phones, cameras, money or other valuables.

If your child requires any medication during the visit, such as travel sickness pills, please contact the school office to complete consent forms. We are unable to administer medication without permission in writing.

Due to the late time of our return, children attending the concert are not required to be in school until 10.00am on Friday 24th January. For safeguarding purposes, please contact the school and let us know if your child will be in at 10am or the usual time of 8.45am. If your child requires a school meal on the day after (Friday 24th), we will also need to know this in advance (menu choices are fish fingers & chips or vegetable fingers & chips). **Please contact the school office with the above information as soon as possible via email to: office@roundhouse.cambs.sch.uk**

If we don't hear back from you, we will assume that your child is having a packed lunch on the Friday.

CONCERT TIMES

Venue doors open at **6pm**. Concerts starts **7pm** and finishes **8.45pm**. Arrive in good time for increased security (please see *Bag Policy info).

PARKING

TICKETS ON ENTRY

To avoid delays at the doors, all tickets are now available exclusively through the AXS app. **Please ensure your mobile tickets are ready to be displayed on your phone screen upon arrival**, and make sure your phone is charged to avoid any issues at the door.

BAG POLICY

The venue encourages customers to **avoid bringing a bag where possible**, if you require a bag please ensure it meets the [*Bag Policy info](#).

MERCHANDISE

Programmes are available to purchase on the night. Your school will be listed in the programme. Other merchandise can be purchased at the arena stands or on the [online shop](#). A video of the concert will be available to purchase after the concert, details will be available on the YV website.

VENUE FOOD AND BEVERAGE OUTLETS

The venue operates a cashless system.

VIDEO CAMERAS

Video equipment and SLR cameras with removable large lenses are strictly prohibited in the arena. Please bring binoculars so you can spot your child in the choir.

END OF CONCERT

Please make your way to the exits as soon as the concert has finished.

POST CONCERT - CHOIR CHILD COLLECTION

Collecting your child from school:

We HIGHLY RECOMMEND you meet your child back at their school, this is the safest option and will avoid a long wait at the end of the concert.

Collecting your child from the arena:

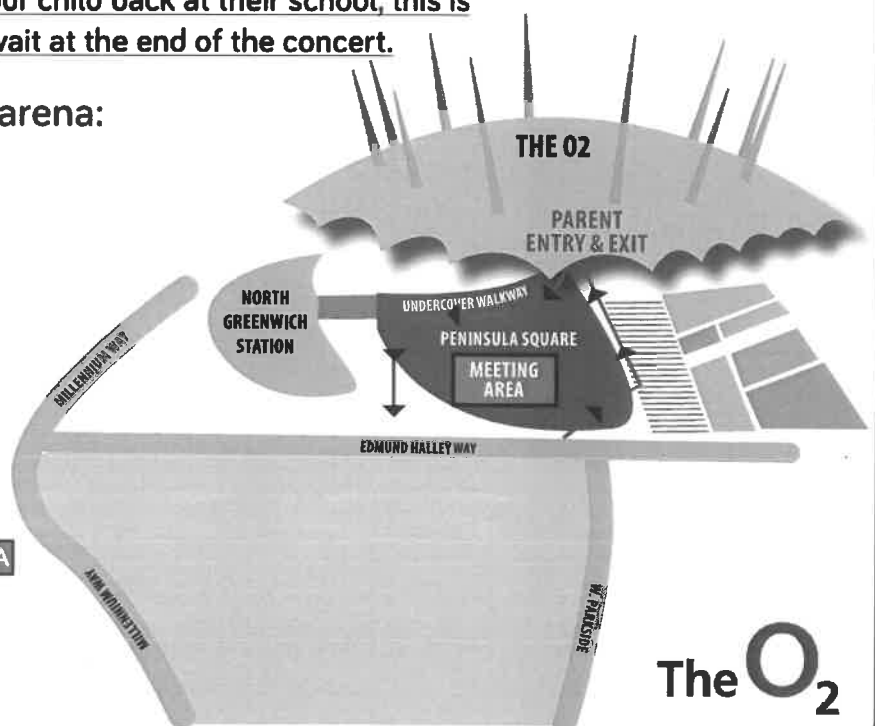
If you are collecting your child from the arena after the concert has finished you must have permission of the teacher in charge.

Parents are asked to leave via the main entrance to the building. The concourse areas must be clear before any choir is dismissed so please leave as soon as you can.

Please follow **parent entry and exit routes** → marked on the map to avoid delays as we will prioritise school groups at the crossing point.

- Pre-arrange with your teacher your designated child collection point within the **MEETING AREA** on Peninsula Square, near the new Design District as shown on the map opposite.

Security and marshals will be waiting to assist you. Please follow their instructions.
