



## **Christmas Events at The Round House – KS2**

Please make sure decorations can be hung on the tree and are not too big! There will be a prize for the most attractive tree decoration in each year and a prize for the overall winner. Please send all decorations to school by the morning of Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December, so that they can be placed on the tree. Please ensure that the decoration has your child's full name and class on it, and then it can be returned home to decorate your Christmas tree this year.

**Please order your CHILD'S CHRISTMAS LUNCH by Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November – EVEN IF YOUR CHILD HAS SCHOOL DINNER EVERY DAY. No orders can be placed for Christmas lunch after this time. The lunch will take place on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> December. An online form will be used to order your child's lunch, and a letter will be sent out today, with more details.**

Reward Day will take place on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December. You will receive a letter to confirm if your child is participating in Reward Day.

The PTA are arranging a Christmas Fair after school on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> December. Please see the parent mail regarding hamper donations and posters around the school for more information. We look forward to seeing you there. Santa will also be attending the fair!

Year 4, 5 and 6 children will be walking to Church for a carol service on the last day of term, Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December. Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof coat and suitable shoes for the walk with them that day.
