## Reception Trip to Shepreth Wildlife Park – Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023

We will be visiting Shepreth Wildlife Park as our Summer trip this year. The visit will link in with our learning on Animals and Minibeasts. The children will be walking around the Wildlife Park and will have the opportunity to meet and greet different animals, as well as completing a classroom session with one of the keepers.

The visit will take place on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2023. We will be leaving school at around **9.00am**, so the children will need to be at school promptly for registration. We will be returning to school for the usual collection time of 3.15pm.

The cost of the visit will be £16.00. This includes entry and coach travel and has been subsidised by the school. This is a voluntary contribution; however, if we do not get enough money to pay for the trip then we will have to cancel it. Please complete and return the attached permission slip together with payment as soon as possible and no later than **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June**. We would prefer payment to be made via the Arbor Parent Portal/Arbor app. If you have not already signed up for this, please let the office know and they will help you with this.

The children will need a packed lunch that day (no fizzy drinks, chocolate or yoghurts) and a back pack, as they will need to carry their lunch with them. As all children in Reception are entitled to a free school meal, we can provide a packed lunch for your child. This will consist of a filled bread roll, a piece of fruit and a cake or biscuit. If you would like your child to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please indicate this on the attached form by 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

All children will need to be in **school uniform** but can wear comfortable trainers and will also need a sun hat, sun cream, a water bottle and a raincoat.
