Trip to the Imperial War Museum at Duxford – Thursday 22nd June 2023

I am delighted to confirm that we have organised our Year 5 trip to the Imperial War Museum at Duxford. This trip will form part of our studies on The Battle of Britain, and will provide the children with a fantastic opportunity to visit the museum, and view and interact with aircraft, vehicles and artefacts from the Second World War.

The total cost of the trip is £8.00 per child. This is a voluntary contribution; however, if we do not get enough money to pay for the trip then we will have to cancel it. Please make your payment via the Arbor App or Parent Portal if possible.

We will be visiting Duxford on Thursday 22nd June, and will be travelling to Duxford by coach. In order to make the most of the time available to us, we will be leaving The Round House at 9:00am and will return to school at approximately 3:15pm. Please ensure your child is with us promptly for registration at 8.35am.

Your child will need the following:

- A packed lunch in a named carrier bag so that this can be thrown away. Please ensure that all items are disposable (no fizzy drinks, yoghurts or chocolate please).
- Small rucksack/bag.
- A named water bottle.
- A named sun hat.
- Small waterproof that can be tied around your child's waist or put in a small bag.
- Please apply sun cream, staff are not permitted to do this.
- Children must wear school uniform.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather conditions on the day e.g. jumper if cold and windy, waterproof jacket etc.
