



Christmas Events at The Round House – KS2

We have been planning Christmas activities for the children to take part in and enjoy during their time at school before the Christmas holidays.



The **Christmas Post Boxes** will be in school from Thursday 1st December, one in each Key Stage. Please ensure that your child writes the full name of the child and the child's class clearly on each envelope, so that every item of Christmas post is delivered to the correct child.

The school will be decorated by the staff after school on Wednesday 30th November. On Thursday 1st December we will have a special assembly where the children will "wish" the Christmas lights on. We are also hoping that each child will make a **Christmas decoration** at home to place on the Christmas tree in school. This can be very simple – made from card, paper and one or two glitzy bits. There will be a prize for the most attractive tree decoration in each year and a prize for the overall winner. Please send all decorations to school by the morning of Thursday 1st December, so that they can be placed on the tree. Please ensure that the decoration has your child's full name and class on it, and then it can be returned home to decorate your Christmas tree this year. Please be aware that all after school clubs are cancelled on Wednesday 30th November.

Please order your CHILD'S CHRISTMAS LUNCH by 10 am on Friday 2nd December – EVEN IF YOUR CHILD HAS SCHOOL DINNER EVERY DAY. No orders can be placed for Christmas lunch after this time. The lunch will take place on Friday 16th December. A separate form will be sent home to book this.

Reward Day will take place on Tuesday 20th December. You will receive a letter to confirm if your child is participating in Reward Day.

The School Council are arranging a Christmas Fair after school on Monday 19th December and further details will be provided by them in due course. Santa will be attending the fair.

We will be walking to Church for a carol service on the last day of term, Wednesday 21st December. Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof coat and suitable shoes for the walk with them that day.

The Year 3 & Year 4 school production will take place in the Spring term and the Year 5 & 6 production will be in the Summer term.
