Dear Parents and Carers,

## After School Clubs – Autumn Term 2022

Please find attached a list of the after school clubs that we will be running this term. You will see that not every club is open to all year groups, but there is lots of choice. **Please keep this information safe for your future reference, the attached schedule indicates any weeks where individual clubs will not be running. Please retain this information for the term.** As before, our after-school clubs are run for children in Years 1-6 in the Autumn and Spring Terms, and in the Summer Term our Reception children are also invited to join in. The club schedule attached to this letter details which clubs are open to which year groups.

There will continue to be a charge for some of our clubs this term. The cost per session of each club is detailed in the attached schedule. This cost will need to be paid for in advance, once you have received confirmation that you have been allocated a place in the club for your child. **If you have/intend to pay the annual contribution for your child, there will be no additional charge to attend any of these after-school clubs.**

## Invitation Only Clubs

School Council, Eco Committee, Year 5 Reading Gladiators, Year 6 Reading Gladiators and Homework club will be run by invitation only this term. If your child has a place in these clubs, they will receive a separate letter informing you of this. **These clubs are not open to all children, please do not select them if your child did not receive an individual invitation.**

**Clubs will start week beginning 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2022, with the exception of Homework Club, School Council, Eco Committee, Year 5 Reading Gladiators and Year 6 Reading Gladiators which will start week commencing 26<sup>th</sup> September.** Homework Club and KS1 Football Club on a Wednesday (with St Neots Football Club) will run for **ONE HOUR**, finishing at 4.15pm. **All other clubs** run for 45 minutes and finish at 4.00pm. The final day for all clubs (including Homework club) will be on **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022**. Clubs that are run by class teachers will not take place on Parents Evening nights, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> October, SEN Parents evening on 19<sup>th</sup> October and this is indicated on the schedule. Clubs run by non-classroom based

teachers or support staff will still take place. There will also be no clubs running on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> November.

Mrs Street will also be running a Crochet Club for children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 on Wednesdays. Details are being sent in a separate email. All bookings must be made directly with Mrs Street as indicated in her leaflet.

If you would like your child to attend one or more of the clubs, please complete the form on the sheet overleaf and **return it to the school office as soon as possible. The deadline for returns is 12.00 noon on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2022. If your child returns the form after this date, we cannot guarantee that they will get a place at a club. Please only sign up for clubs that your child intends to attend weekly. Children who regularly miss sessions of their club will be removed and the place offered to another child on the waiting list.**

Can you please also indicate on the form how your child will be getting home after their club/s. Please state if you will be collecting your child from the club/s, if they are allowed to walk home on their own, if they will be attending Magpies after their club finishes, or if there are any other arrangements in place. Please email [magpies@roundhouse.cambs.sch.uk](mailto:magpies@roundhouse.cambs.sch.uk) to let them know if your child will be attending Magpies after their club once you know a place has been allocated. As previously stated, if you wish to cancel your child's place at Magpies, you will need to email them to give them one month's notice of the cancellation and a place may not be available if you need one in the future.

We will do our best to ensure that every child can attend at least one club and any additional clubs will only be allocated if spaces are available. If your child is not allocated a place in a club, they will automatically be added to the waiting list and you will be contacted if a place becomes available at a later date.

Please could we ask that if your child starts attending a club, but decides that they no longer wish to continue for any reason, that you let the school office know as soon as possible that they will no longer attend. Nearly all of our clubs have waiting lists, and we would like to offer any available spaces to those on the lists as they become available.
