## Year 3 and 4 History Off the Page – 'Ancient Egyptian' Day

In September, as a way of providing your child with the best opportunity to find out about life in Ancient Egypt, we have arranged for *History Off the Page* to spend the day with us on **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> September (for Year 3)** and **Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> September (for Year 4)**. 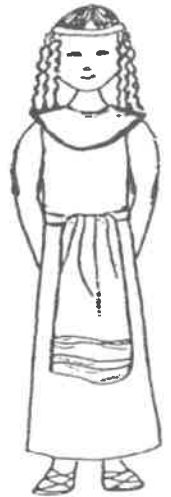
## Preparing the pupils – Ancient Egyptian costume ideas:

Looking like an Egyptian will help you feel like an Egyptian. Costumes do not have to be fancy – you can do a lot with a large white T-shirt! Here are some ideas:

**Tunic:** This can be a simple white dress for or a large white T-shirt. You can also make one from a pillowcase, or even an old sheet: fold it over, stitch up the sides and cut a hole in top for your head. You may wear this with a simple thin apron.

**Sandals:** Simple leather sandals are good, but any sensible footwear will do.

**Collar:** A collar is not essential, but you can make one with a circular piece of cardboard with a hole cut into it for your head. You can decorate it with Egyptian-style patterns.



**Tunic:** Using a large white T-shirt. You can also make one from a pillowcase, or even an old sheet: fold it over, stitch up the sides and cut a hole in top for your head.

This can be worn with a belt, cord or sash around the waist.

**Sandals:** Simple leather sandals are good, but any sensible footwear will do.
