Please be aware that **NO** Pre-School or Primary School aged children or babies will be admitted to either of the evening performances. Should you want to bring a younger child to see the show, tickets are available for the Tuesday afternoon performance. Please be aware that if any younger children come to the evening performances, you will be asked to take them home. KS2, KS1 and Reception children at The Round House will be seeing the production at the dress rehearsal.

The evening performances will begin at 5.30pm, so the children will need to be in their classroom at 5.00pm to prepare. **Children must be taken to and collected from their classroom even if they usually walk home alone.** We will let you know the collection time nearer the performance once we have a more accurate idea of the length of the production. If there are any issues with attendance, please inform your class teacher as soon as possible. It is crucial that we know well in advance if your child cannot attend either of the evening performances, although we strongly request that this does not happen unless there are exceptional circumstances, as all children have their part to play whether it's on stage, in the singing and/or dancing.

Please ensure that if your child has lines or songs to learn, they know them off by heart as soon as possible.
