Year 6 SATs

You are no doubt aware that the Year 6 children are due to take their SATs during the week commencing Monday 9th May 2022. Please find the timetable for these assessments below:

<u>Date</u>	<u>Test</u>
Monday 9 th May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling test Paper 1: Short answer questions Paper 2: Spelling task
Tuesday 10 th May	English reading test
Wednesday 11 th May	Mathematics Paper 1: Arithmetic Paper 2: Reasoning A
Thursday 12 th May	Mathematics Paper 3: Reasoning B

The Maths papers test the children's knowledge of these subjects – they are not designed to test their reading ability. So please join with us and tell the children to ask us to read the questions to them if needed. The only test where we cannot do this is obviously the reading test.

The SATs are extremely important to your child, as an individual and to the school as a whole. It is vital that your child attends school during this week, as it is not possible to take a test at any other time apart from the specified day/dates. If your child is ill please notify the school as early as possible.

To make the week a little less stressful, we will be holding a breakfast club from 8.15am on Monday – Thursday; there is no charge for this club. Please complete and return the slip on the attached page if you would like your child to attend. We would encourage all children to attend.
