



Christmas Events at The Round House – KS1

We have been planning Christmas activities for the children to take part in and enjoy during their time at school before the Christmas holidays.



The **Christmas Post Boxes** will be in school from Wednesday 1st December, one in each Key Stage. Please ensure that your child writes the full name of the child and the child's class clearly on each envelope, so that every item of Christmas post is delivered to the correct child.

The school will be decorated by the staff after school on Tuesday 30th November ready for the festivities to begin. On Wednesday 1st December we will be having a special assembly where the children will "wish" the Christmas lights on. We are also hoping that each child will make a **Christmas decoration** at home to place on one of the Christmas trees in around school. This can be very simple – made from card, paper and one or two glitzy bits. There will be a prize for the most attractive tree decoration in each year and a prize for the overall winner. Please send all decorations to school by the morning of Wednesday 1st December, so that they can be placed on the trees. Please ensure that the decoration has your child's full name and class on it, and then it can be returned home to decorate your Christmas tree this year.

Please order your CHILD'S CHRISTMAS LUNCH by 10am on Friday 3rd December – EVEN IF YOUR CHILD HAS SCHOOL DINNER EVERY DAY. No orders can be placed for Christmas lunch after this time. The lunch will take place on Wednesday 15th December.

Father Christmas will be visiting Key Stage 1, which is always a very exciting event.



KS1 will be having a Christmas Party in the afternoon of 17th December. A sign up sheet for donating party food will be put up nearer the time.

Reward Day is on Thursday 16th December and KS1 children can come to school in their own clothes on this day.

We are also creating a Santa's Grotto where your child will be able to visit Santa on 6th & 7th December after school. We will send out further details once the plans have been finalised.
