This can be very simple – made from card, paper and one or two glitzy bits. There will be a prize for the most attractive tree decoration in each year and a prize for the overall winner. Please send all decorations to school by the morning of Wednesday 1st December, so that they can be placed on the trees. Please ensure that the decoration has your child's full name and class on it, and then it can be returned home to decorate your Christmas tree this year.

Please order your CHILD'S CHRISTMAS LUNCH by 10am on Friday 3rd December – EVEN IF YOUR CHILD HAS SCHOOL DINNER EVERY DAY. No orders can be placed for Christmas lunch after this time. The lunch will take place on Wednesday 15th December.
