## **Year 4 trip to Go Ape**

Part of the Year 4 trip to Go Ape includes the Go Ape Treetop Adventure and we have to sign an acknowledgement and disclaimer on behalf of your children as follows:

1. The Go Ape Treetop Adventure is an aerial obstacle course ('the Activity') where, once an instructor has attached a participant to the safety system, he or she cannot become detached. However, as with any physical activity there remains a degree of risk and the Activity can be physically, mentally and emotionally demanding.
2. All participants must be a minimum height of 1m for the Treetop Adventure
  - a) Juniors aged 6 and over require a minimum of one adult per group of eight juniors to supervise them on the course or from the ground. In order to control behaviour supervisors must remain in visual contact of the children in their care for the duration of the Activity.
3. I have carefully considered all of the risks involved in undertaking the Activity, including the risk of bumps, scrapes, cuts, bruises and other injuries and agree to undertake the Activity and/or give consent for the child(ren) to participate in this Activity.
4. I understand that Go Ape accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury caused by or during participation in the Activity, except where the loss, damage or injury was caused directly by Go Ape's negligence.
5. I certify that any child I am signing for, do not have any medical conditions which might make it more likely that he/she be involved in an accident which could result in injury to him/herself or others.
6. I confirm that I have authority from the child's parent or guardian to sign this consent form.

You have already given consent for your child to attend the trip, but if you are not happy with the terms of the above acknowledgement and disclaimer please email the school office by Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> July. Your child will still be able to take part in all the other parts of the day.

Please ensure that your child arrives promptly at 8.40am so that we are ready to leave on time. As this trip involves physical activity, children should wear their P.E. kit but should also bring their school jumper. Whilst we recommend that your child dresses appropriately for the weather, please note these clothes could get dirty and we would advise wearing longer jogger style bottoms (no leggings) to make wearing a harness more comfortable. Please ensure long hair is tied back and your child wears their trainers on the day of the trip.

As mentioned previously, please also ensure that your child brings a rucksack that can carry their:

Packed lunch (no sweets)  
2 drinks (no glass bottles or cans)  
A named sunhat  
A named waterproof jacket  
Sun cream that they can apply themselves.

Please note that the children are due back at approximately 4.30pm.
