



## Christmas Events at The Round House – KS1

We have therefore been planning Christmas activities for the children to take part in and enjoy during their time at school before the Christmas holidays.



Unfortunately, we are unable to have the **Christmas Post Boxes** in school this year as we are still limiting the amount of items that are brought into school. Your child may still bring in cards for their friends within their year group bubble.

The school will, as usual, be decorated by the staff after school on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November ready for the festivities to begin. As a school we are looking to decorate using sustainable materials, and I have been impressed with the ideas that the children and staff have come up with. Unfortunately we will not be able to hold our usual whole school special assembly where the children “wish” the Christmas lights on as we are only able to mix within our bubbles, however we will perform a virtual “wish” and I am sure that each class will be decorated beautifully. We are still hoping that each child will make a **Christmas decoration** at home to place on a Christmas tree that will be located within each phase of the school. Thank you to Pirie Homes Estate Agents for donating the trees. The decoration can be very simple – made from card, paper and one or two glitzy bits and does not need to be made by the child. There will be a prize for the most attractive tree decoration in each year and a prize for the overall winner. Please send all decorations to school by the morning of Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> December, so that they can be placed on their tree that morning. Please ensure that the decoration has your child's full name and class on it, and then it can be returned home to decorate your Christmas tree this year.

It is really important that you complete the form with a choice for your child's main course and pudding – EVEN IF YOUR CHILD HAS A SCHOOL DINNER EVERY DAY as the cook will base their order on this information. KS1 will be having a Christmas Party within their bubble and your class teacher will provide more information nearer the time.
