To promote a love of maths the Pre-school have developed a large bank of personalised interactive maths bags. These will be used to promote all of the children's understanding of numbers, size and shape during adult led activities.

The Pre-school welcomed a visit from some Giant African Land Snails. The children could hold or observe them. We used the opportunity to link to knowledge and understanding of the world. As you can imagine, it was very exciting!



The children have shown an interest in 'gymnastics' at Pre-school. We have planned experiences to promote their gross motor skills in a fun and safe way.

Next week we will be reading the book 'Errol's Garden' by Gillian Hibbs and our theme is The Natural World.
