Homework

- Spellings – will be available on ClassDojo. These will be set each Monday.
- Maths.co.uk - children are expected to complete tasks set for them on a weekly basis. This will be set and checked on Mondays.
- TTRockstars - children are expected to complete 10 minutes of Garage set for them on a weekly basis. This will be set and checked on Mondays.

P.E.

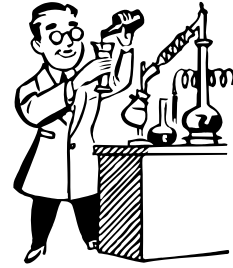
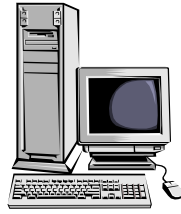

Art

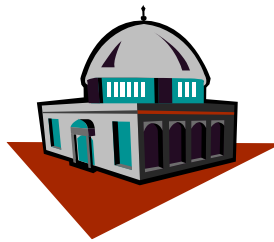
Our unit is 'Craft Design: Photo Opportunity'. The children will explore different photographic techniques, creating images through photomontage and photorealistic portraits whilst enhancing their skills in composition and editing.

Computing

The children will be learning about Bletchley Park and codebreaking. As well as this, they will be designing their own websites.

Science

Our first unit is 'Living Things and their Habitats'. The children will learn about micro-organisms and the identification and classification of different animals and plants.



History

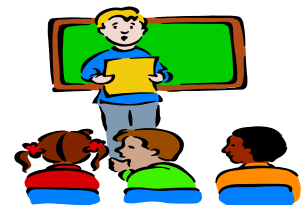
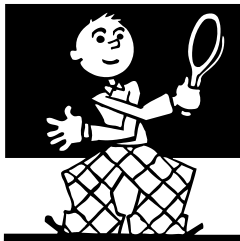
We will be studying the Ancient Greeks in our History lessons, understanding their importance and the impact they had on the world.

Religion and Worldviews

Music
