TTRS Homework

Maths homework will be set on Monday and will be due the following Monday. They are expected to complete **thirty games** on TT Rockstar in garage mode. Teachers will be checking on the Monday that these have been completed. Paper copies of TTRS are available in the Year 3 classrooms for pupils to collect.

Spelling Homework

Spelling lists are sent out in a three-week block on ClassDojo for the children to work on. Alongside this, teachers will attach a sheet with separate ways for children to engage with these words, helping them to break down the patterns and revise different strategies for rehearsal. Alternatively, children could follow a look, cover, write technique if this approach works better for them. There is no set time requirement for these tasks, but we are sure that you share our belief that extra practice conducted at home is hugely beneficial to your child's learning process. The spelling words are also put on Spelling Shed.

Reading

Children will complete their essential 10-minute reading in school and complete their quiz for their completed books in school. Any reading at home is for pleasure. Children can update Track My Read to celebrate their additional reading at home. In Year 3, we celebrate reading for pleasure with Top 100 and visits to the reading space as well.

Additional Writing Tasks

On our class pages, the Year 3 team have placed writing suggestions for children to complete if they would like to. They can bring these into school when finished to be celebrated by the class teacher.

PE

Please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing and footwear in school for PE and outdoor lessons. For PE,













- a white t-shirt,

Letters will be sent home if children forget their P.E kit. There are further consequences if children continue to forget their kit. Please refer to the uniform policy.
