



Year 6 Curriculum Newsletter **Autumn Term 2024**

Dear Parents & Carers

Welcome back for another year at The Round House! We hope you are as excited for your children to be back at school as we are and that you are looking forward to an important year ahead. We are sure you will agree that Year 6 is a significant year in the life of your children as they will embark on their last year at Primary school before moving on towards secondary school. Please find below a summary of the main learning areas during this first term, along with some general reminders.

Homework

Reading - children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes, 5 times a week from their AR book and this should be recorded in their reading diary (date, name of book, page number) and signed by an adult. The number of reads will be counted up each Friday, so children must ensure that they have their reading diary and their AR book with them (along with a 100 read book if they have one of these too). AR club will continue to run.

Spelling Shed - children are expected to complete tasks set by the class teacher each week. These will be set each Monday and completed by the following Monday.

Maths.co.uk - children are expected to complete tasks set for them on a weekly basis. This will be set and checked on Mondays.

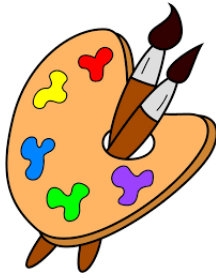
P.E.

We are looking forward to an exciting term ahead and thank you in advance for your support.

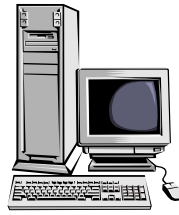

Autumn Term 2024 - Curriculum for Year 6



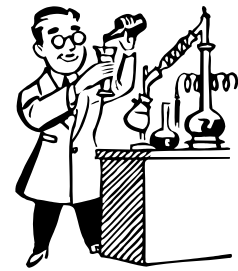
Art

Our unit is 'Craft Design: Photo Opportunity'. The children will explore different photographic techniques, creating images through photomontage and photorealistic portraits whilst enhancing their skills in composition and editing.



Computing

The children will be learning about Bletchley Park and codebreaking. As well as this, they will be designing their own websites.



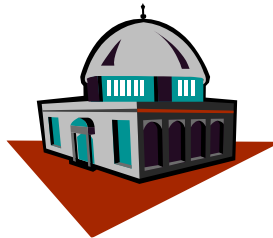
Science

We will be studying the Ancient Greeks in our History lessons, understanding their importance and the impact they had on the world.



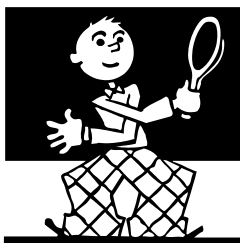
Religion and Worldviews

The children will be looking at the music used in television and film to understand its purpose and importance.



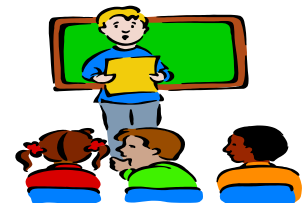
P.E.
